

Nubbins Dishcloth

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This is a super simple dishcloth with a twist. The nubbins are created by casting on then immediately binding off these new stitches.

Materials:

- Peaches n' Crème or Sugar n' Cream cotton (1 skein)
- US Size 7 (4.5 mm) needles

Gauge: 16 sts x 30 rows in garter stitch (After washing). Gauge is not that important with this cloth.

Finished size: approx. 10" square (After washing)

Instructions: Cast on 40 sts.

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Cast on 2 sts using the **Knitted Cast On** method. Bind off 2 sts, knit across the rest of row (40 sts).

Repeat Row 2 until there are 38 garter ridges (or to preferred length). Make sure all rows end up with only 40 sts after binding off the 2 sts at the beginning of the row.

Last Row: Cast on 2 sts, bind off whole row. Weave in loose ends.

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
