

Nubbins for Ta-tas Dishcloth

As women, most of us are aware that we need to examine our breasts regularly. What better way to remind ourselves more often to do that than to use a dishcloth that blatantly screams "Feel the Ta-tas".

This cloth is a deviation from the original Nubbins Dishcloth. A few things have changed:

- the needle suggested is one size smaller
- the nubs at the edges occur at every other ridge (instead of at the edge of every row)



Materials:

- Sugar n' Cream Twists (100% cotton 2 oz./95 yds) color: Rose Twist 1 skein
- US Size 6 (4.0 mm) needles

Gauge: 18 sts x 36 rows in garter stitch. Gauge is only important if concerned about running out yarn.

Finished size:

10.25" wide by 9.5" high (before washing)
9.5" wide by 8" high (after washing)

Abbreviations:

K = Knit

P = Purl

K2tog = Knit 2 sts together

Make Nubb: Cast on 2 sts using the *Knitted Cast On* method (see Note 1). Bind off the 2 sts just made.

Make Bobble: Knit in front and back and in front again in the next stitch on the left needle, turn. P3, turn. Slip 1 st, K2tog, pass slipped stitch over the last stitch made. Continue as instructed across row.

Note 2: All rows will end up having a total of 45 sts when completed.

Instructions:

Cast on 45 sts.

Section 1:

Rows 1 & 2: Make Nubb, Knit across.

Rows 3 & 4: Knit across.

Repeat Rows 1-4 five (5) more times.

Repeat Rows 1 & 2. There should be 14 garter ridges on the right side.

Section 2:

If using the chart, begin at Row 1. Written directions are as follows:

Row 1: K8, P11, K7, P11, K8.

Row 2: K13, P3, K13, P3, K13.

Row 3: Make Nubb, K8, P3, K7, P3, K3, P3, K7, P3, K8.

Row 4: Make Nubb, K10, P9, K7, P9, K10.

Row 5: K6, P4, K9, P3, K1, P3, K9, P4, K6.

Row 6: K9, P11, K5, P11, K9.

Row 7: Make Nubb, K6, P3, K11, P5, K11, P3, K6.

Row 8: Make Nubb, K8, P13, K3, P13, K8.

Row 9: K5, P3, K13, P3, K13, P3, K5.

Row 10: K8, P13, K3, P13, K8.

Row 11: Make Nubb, K5, P2, K15, P1, K15, P2, K5.

Row 12: Make Nubb, K7, P15, K1, P15, K7.

Row 13: K5, P2, K15, P1, K15, P2, K5.

Row 14: K7, P15, K1, P15, K7.

Row 15: Make Nubb, K5, P2, K7, Make Bobble, K7, P1, K7, Make Bobble, K7, P2, K5.

Row 16: Make Nubb, K7, P15, K1, P15, K7.

Row 17: K5, P3, K13, P3, K13, P3, K5.

Row 18: K8, P13, K3, P13, K8.

Row 19: Make Nubb, K5, P3, K13, P3, K13, P3, K5.

Row 20: Make Nubb, K8, P13, K3, P13, K8.

Row 21: K6, P3, K11, P2, K1, P2, K11, P3, K6.

Row 22: K9, P11, K5, P11, K9.

Row 23: Make Nubb, K8, P2, K9, P2, K3, P2, K9, P2, K8.

Row 24: Make Nubb, K10, P9, K7, P9, K10.

Row 25: K8, P3, K7, P3, K3, P3, K7, P3, K8.

Row 26: K13, P3, K13, P3, K13.

Row 27: Make Nubb, K10, P9, K7, P9, K10.

Row 28: Make Nubb, Knit across.

Section 3:

Rows 1 & 2: Knit across.

Rows 3 & 4: Make Nubb, Knit across.

Repeat Rows 1-4 four (4) more times.

Repeat Rows 1-3.

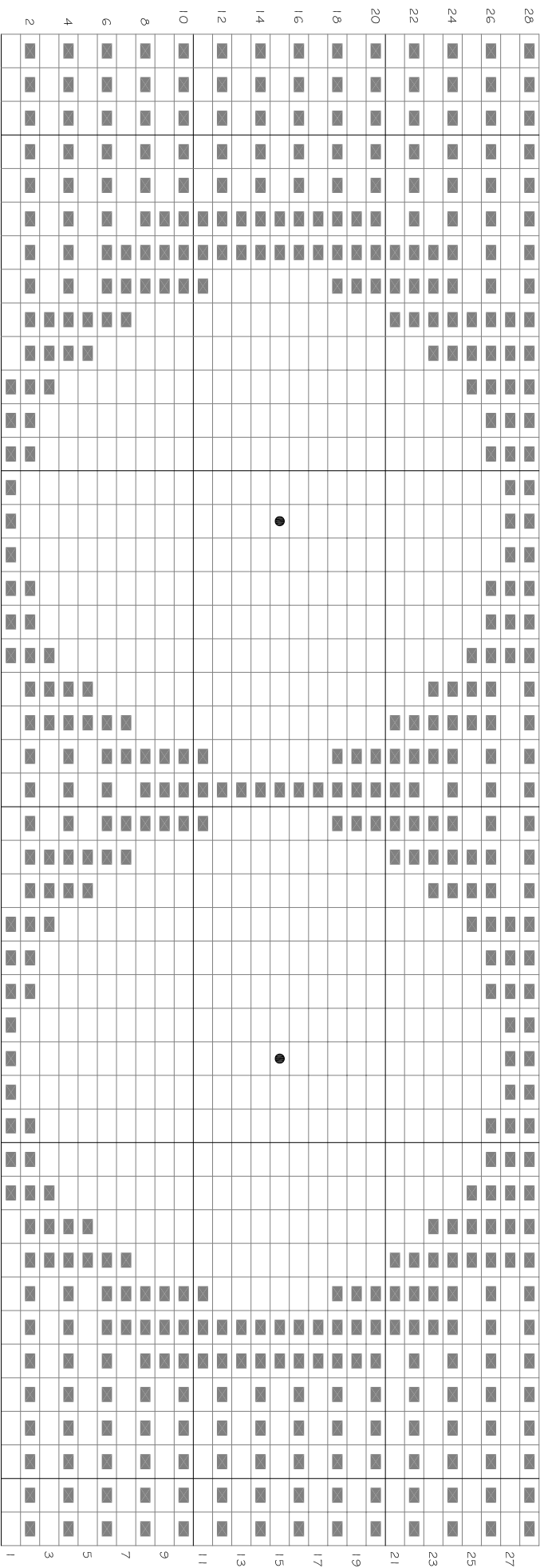
Bind off row: Make Nubb, bind off rest of row. Break yarn. Weave in yarn tails.
