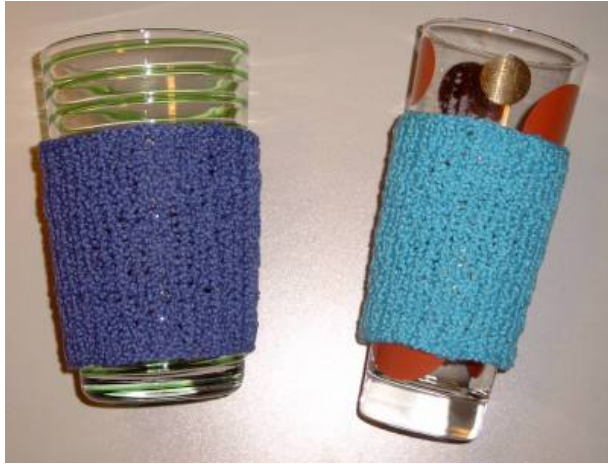


Star Cup Cozies

These cup cozies are great for hot and humid climates. They help to end the puddles that pool under glasses of ice cold beverages. The cozies pictured above done in Classic Elite **Star** yarn, which is a cotton/elastic blend and makes them super stretchy. They are versatile and fit many different sizes of glasses.



(The cozies shown at left are made using Cascade Fixation)



Materials:

- Classic Elite Star 1 skein (makes several cozies) 99% cotton/1% Lycra 50gms/112 yds
- Cascade Fixation or Elann Esprit 98.3% cotton/1.7% elastic 50gms 186 yds/170 m (stretched) or 100 yds/91.4 m (relaxed)
- US #4 (3.5 mm) set of dpns

Gauge: 6 to 6.5 sts per inch in rib pattern (while relaxed)

Finished size: roughly 6.5" circumference

Abbreviations:

K = Knit	St = stitch
P = Purl	RS = right side
CO = cast on	WS = wrong side

Instructions:

Cast on loosely 40 sts. Divide over 3 dpns: 1st needle = 14 sts, 2nd needle = 12 sts, 3rd needle = 14 sts. Join, being careful not to twist.

All rows: *K1, P1, repeat from * across row. Work until cozy is desired length. Bind off loosely in pattern. Weave in yarn tails.
