

Wedgie Scarf

Materials:

- SWTC Karaoke color 277 **2 skeins** (50% soy silk/50% wool) 50gms/109 yds **or**
- Noro Kureyon **2 skeins** (100% wool) 50gms/108 yds
- US #7 (4.5 mm) needles

Gauge: Not crucial for this pattern

Finished size: 61 inches long by 4.5 wide

Abbreviations:

K = Knit

P = Purl

Sl = slip stitch as if to knit

SSK = slip, slip, knit these 2 sts together

Wrap & Turn = Sl 1 st, bring yarn to front, **put Sl st back on left needle**, turn work

Slip Edge ST = Knit to last st, SL last knitted st on right needle back to left needle and P5SO leaving st on left needle. Bring yarn forward between needles and turn.

Inc = increase

Dec = decrease

CO = cast on

St = stitch

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

Note:

Most numbered rows in the instructions are actually two rows completed. This is due to the Wrap and Turn of the short rows.

*Refer to diagram at end of instructions to see relationship of Wedges to each other.

This wasn't intentionally designed for a man. But as I always ask the guys in my household their opinions on my designs, this was a winner with both of them. Maybe it had something to do with the colors but there isn't much here that you can call frilly or lacy. And as many designs for men go, this can be made for a woman also. I myself like the charcoal colors in this version. I also didn't want to make it too skinny or too long. I've made a version in Noro Kureyon (that was recycled from a boring scarf) with interesting coloration results. The texture of the Karaoke turns out smooth and the Kureyon has a more rustic texture.

Disclaimer:

The ends of the scarf are not identical. See photo on page 2.

Instructions:

Wedge #1

CO 18 sts. Knit one row. (WS)

Row 1: (RS) K16, Wrap & Turn, K16
Row 2: (RS) K15, Wrap & Turn, K15
Row 3: (RS) K14, Wrap & Turn, K14
Row 4: (RS) K13, Wrap & Turn, K13
Row 5: (RS) K12, Wrap & Turn, K12
Row 6: (RS) K11, Wrap & Turn, K11
Row 7: (RS) K10, Wrap & Turn, K10
Row 8: (RS) K9, Wrap & Turn, K9
Row 9: (RS) K8, Wrap & Turn, K8
Row 10: (RS) K7, Wrap & Turn, K7
Row 11: (RS) K6, Wrap & Turn, K6
Row 12: (RS) K5, Wrap & Turn, K5
Row 13: (RS) K4, Wrap & Turn, K4
Row 14: (RS) K3, Wrap & Turn, K3
Row 15: (RS) K2, Wrap & Turn, K2
Row 16: (RS) K1, Wrap & Turn, K1
Row 17: (RS) K all sts

Wedge #2

Repeat Rows 1-17 with the exception that the rows will begin on the WS.



Wedge #3

Row 1: (RS) K16, Wrap & Turn, K16
Row 2: (RS) K15, Wrap & Turn, K3,P9,K3
Row 3: (RS) K14, Wrap & Turn, K3,P8,K3
Row 4: (RS) K13, Wrap & Turn, K3,P7,K3
Row 5: (RS) K12, Wrap & Turn, K3,P6,K3
Row 6: (RS) K11, Wrap & Turn, K3,P5,K3
Row 7: (RS) K10, Wrap & Turn, K3,P4,K3
Row 8: (RS) K9, Wrap & Turn, K3,P3,K3
Row 9: (RS) K8, Wrap & Turn, K3,P2,K3
Row 10: (RS) K7, Wrap & Turn, K3,P1,K3
Row 11: (RS) K6, Wrap & Turn, K6
Row 12: (RS) K5, Wrap & Turn, K5
Row 13: (RS) K4, Wrap & Turn, K4
Row 14: (RS) K3, Wrap & Turn, K3
Row 15: (RS) K2, Wrap & Turn, K2
Row 16: (RS) K1, Wrap & Turn, K1
Row 17: (RS) K all sts

Wedge #4

Row 1 & 2: Same as Wedge #2
Row 3: (WS) K3,P8,K3, Wrap & Turn, K14
Row 4: (WS) K3,P7,K3, Wrap & Turn, K13
Row 5: (WS) K3,P6,K3, Wrap & Turn, K12
Row 6: (WS) K3,P5,K3, Wrap & Turn, K11
Row 7: (WS) K3,P4,K3, Wrap & Turn, K10
Row 8: (WS) K3,P3,K3, Wrap & Turn, K9
Row 9: (WS) K3,P2,K3, Wrap & Turn, K8
Row 10: (WS) K3,P1,K3, Wrap & Turn, K7
Row 11: (WS) K6, Wrap & Turn, K6
Row 12: (WS) K5, Wrap & Turn, K5
Row 13: (WS) K4, Wrap & Turn, K4
Row 14: (WS) K3, Wrap & Turn, K3
Row 15: (WS) K2, Wrap & Turn, K2
Row 16: (WS) K1, Wrap & Turn, K1
Row 17: (WS) K all sts

Wedgie Scarf

Repeat Wedges 1-4 six more times.

Repeat Wedges 1-2 one more time.

End Wedge:

Row 1: Knit to last st, Slip Edge ST, Turn

Row 2: Knit to last 3 sts, SSK, K1.

Repeat Rows 1 & 2 until 4 sts remain.

Repeat Row 1 (3 sts).

K2tog, put st just made back on left needle & PSSO. Break yarn and pull through st.

Weave in yarn tails.

Block lightly.

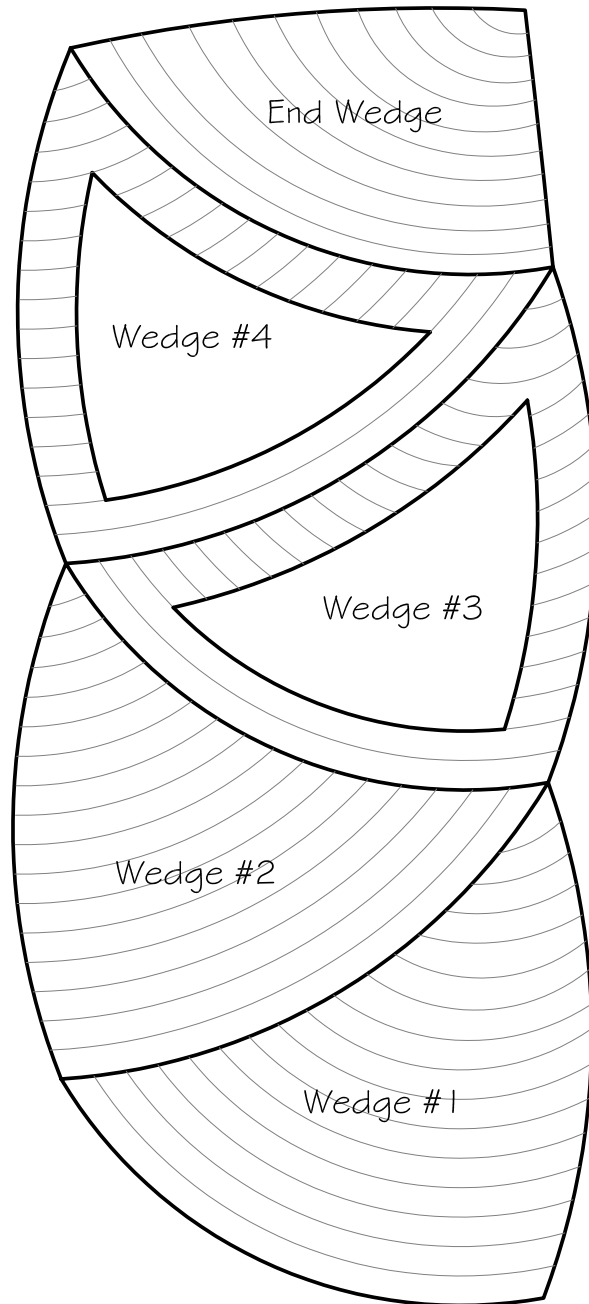
